The Cultural Connector coordinates and supports all aspects of cultural knowledge transfer and planning within Community Wellness. The Cultural Connector provides access to traditional teachings and ceremonies in a safe and acceptable environment and also coordinates access to Elders and Traditional people to meet the needs of Community Wellness, community, children, youth and families as the primary audience.

Responsibilities:

- ❖ The Cultural Resource Worker will work to promote cultural awareness, safety and competency within the community while promoting healing and reconciliation,
- ❖ Build the skills and knowledge within the SCN of local and traditional Indigenous ways of life,
- ❖ Facilitate increased access to culture and cultural knowledge from a perspective that promotes healing among Samson, clients and participants; youth, adults and families,
- ❖ Ensure safe transmission of cultural knowledge for the Maskwacis community,
- ❖ Foster connections to cultural knowledge and ways of being both Samson services and Maskwacis community that promotes reconciliation,
- ❖ Act as a cultural resource and support as required,
- ❖ Develop a well maintained list of credible Elders, healers, and knowledge keepers.

- Ensure the provisions of Indigenous cultural teachings and knowledge within all aspects of programming within Samson Cree Nation and to ensure safe and appropriate cultural practices and boundaries,

- Act as a cultural resource and support as required,
- Promote healing and reconciliation for youth, adults and family units.
